FAQ German Mobility Award 2023

Who can apply?

The German Mobility Award (DMP) is open to anyone who wants to contribute to the shaping of the mobility of the future with their ideas and work. It is a prerequisite that the projects meet the <u>Conditions of Participation</u>. There are no fees involved in participating in the German Mobility Award.

What projects can I enter?

The German Mobility Award (DMP) recognizes projects, products, and applications in four <u>award categories</u>. There will also be an audience award. Additional information can be found in the <u>Conditions of Participation</u>.

Can I apply with a project that I have submitted to the German Mobility Award in previous years?

Projects are eligible for application as long as they have not been awarded the German Mobility Award in previous years.

Can I apply with more than one project?

There is no limit to the number of applications per applicant.

Can I apply with a project that is also funded by the Federal Ministry for Digital and Transport (BMDV) or other ministries?

It is possible to apply with a project that is also funded by the Federal Ministry for Digital and Transport (BMDV) or other ministries.

Can I apply with a project if I am not a German citizen?

The only requirement for an application is that your project is based in Germany. In addition, applications for mobility projects with a focus abroad may also be considered.

What is the application period?

Applications can be submitted from June 21, 2023. The deadline for submission is September 30, 2023 11:59 p.m. CET.

How can I apply?

Applications can be submitted using the application form.

Can changes be made to applications that have already been fully submitted?

Before you submit your application, you can change and update your information at any time. Once the application has been submitted, however, it is no longer possible to edit the application form. In the login area, you can always see an overview of all the projects you have created.

Can I get help filling out the form?

You can get answers to all your application questions at four application coaching sessions. All dates and more information can be found <u>here</u>.

Can my registration for the German Mobility Award be deleted?

Your profile and all associated data can be deleted at any time by sending an e-mail to <u>info@mobilitaetspreis.de</u>.

Can I access my old profile?

You can access your saved profile at any time by entering your login details in the login area. Please note that changes can only be made to future submissions. Changes to completed submissions will not be possible.

Change or reset password

If you need to change your old password for security reasons or because you have forgotten it, a new password can be set in the login area by clicking on "Forgot password".

I submitted a project, but I did not receive a confirmation e-mail. What should I do?

If this happens, please contact us by e-mail.

Who can nominate projects, products, and applications for the German Mobility Award?

In principle, anyone can nominate projects, products, and applications. In exceptional cases, different rules apply. These rules can be found in the <u>Conditions of Participation</u>.

How do I suggest a project, product, or application?

To suggest a project, product, or application, you must complete and submit the entry form between June 21, 2023 and September 15, 2023.

What happens if a project, product, or application proposal is rejected?

If a project, product, or application proposal is rejected, the project is automatically eliminated from the application process.

How will the winners be selected?

After the application deadline on September 30, 2023, a panel of experts will select a longlist of 36 entries from all applications and proposals using an evaluation matrix.

The jury will evaluate the longlist entries according to the competition criteria and select 12 entries for the shortlist.

At a secret jury meeting, jury members will vote collectively on which projects will be given the first place in the four award categories.

The German Mobility Award winners will be announced at an awards ceremony. Each shortlisted project will receive transparent feedback from the jury following the awards ceremony.

In addition to the awards in the four categories, an audience award will be presented. The audience award will be determined by live voting during the awards ceremony. Voting is open to all, either online via livestream or on-site. Further information, including details about dates, can be found <u>here</u>.

Who is on the jury?

The jury consists of experts from politics, administration, business, academia, and civil society who are familiar with the topics of digital transformation, mobility, and innovation. One seat is allocated to a representative of the Federal Ministry for Digital and Transport (BMDV), another to an individual with special expertise in the field of innovation, one to an individual who brings an external perspective, and one to a former award winner. A member of the public completes the jury. You can apply for a seat <u>here.</u>

What if I am not satisfied with a project?

How, when, and where will the audience vote take place?

The recipient(s) of the Audience Choice Award will be determined via live voting during the awards ceremony. Voting is open to everyone, either online via livestream or on-site. All dates and information can be found <u>here</u>.

When and how will the award winners be announced?

The winners will be announced on the awards ceremony in Berlin. The event will be streamed live. All dates and information can be found <u>here</u>

How can I vote for the German Mobility Audience Award?

What are the goals of the German Mobility Award?

Each year, the German Mobility Award honors forward-looking projects, applications, and products that use digital innovations to create intelligent, sustainable, and inclusive mobility while taking people's needs into account. In addition, the German Mobility Award aims to anchor the topics of digitization and mobility in the public sphere, promote innovations, strengthen networks, expand contacts, and set political priorities.

What is there to win?

The German Mobility Award is not a cash prize. Instead, all shortlisted projects receive a high level of public attention and the chance to promote themselves with one of the most important awards in the digital mobility sector. In addition, there are numerous exclusive networking opportunities and all of the projects, products, and applications receive transparent feedback from the jury.

Who is behind the DMP?

In 2022, the Federal Ministry for Digital and Transport (BMDV) commissioned iRights.Lab and the Gesellschaft für Informatik e. V. with the planning, implementation, and supervision of the German Mobility Award.
